

VILLAGE OF COAL VALLEY QUALIFICATIONS
TO BECOME A POLICE OFFICER

To be eligible to take part in the selection process, an applicant for the position of Police must possess the following qualifications:

1. 21 years of age (at time of appointment).
2. No felony convictions or any disqualifying misdemeanor convictions.
3. Not prohibited by any state, any court action and/or state or federal statute from carrying a firearm.
4. High school diploma or equivalent.
5. Applicants must possess a State of Illinois Certification for Police Officer (Full or Part-time).

At the time of appointment, a Police Officer must be a U.S. Citizen and must possess a valid Illinois Drivers License.

Applicants are required to pass a post-offer pre-employment physical examination including a drug screen.

Police Officers must establish residency within one (1) year of date of appointment, (twenty (20) miles from the Coal Valley Village Hall.)
